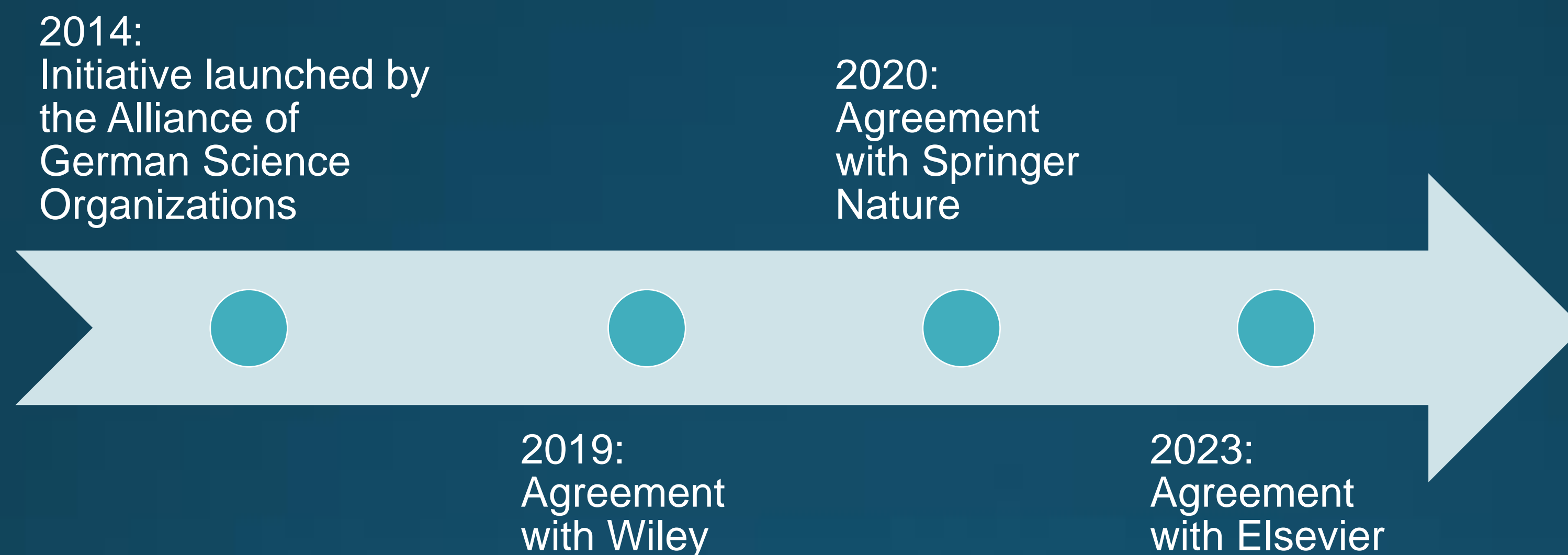
What are the DEAL Agreements with Wiley, Springer Nature, and Elsevier?

The DEAL Consortium negotiates and implements Open Access agreements with the three largest academic publishers — Wiley, Springer Nature, and Elsevier. These agreements allow researchers to publish their work in a wide range of internationally recognized hybrid Open Access journals, with publication costs covered by their institutions.

What are the core objectives?

- ✓ Transition from subscription-based models to Open Access agreements
- ✓ Replace subscriptions with Publish and Read fees
- ✓ Ensure fair and transparent pricing
- ✓ Provide Open Access to research articles and full journal portfolios for institutions
- ✓ Strengthen Open Science

-  Long-term, uniform access conditions for all participants
-  Greater reach and legal certainty through Open Access
-  Broad range of services (e.g., publication rights, permanent read access, reduced publishing fees)
-  Sustainability through efficient infrastructure, regular data reporting, and community services
