# What do Colors in Open Access mean?

If you want to publish your publication Open Access, there are different models you can consider. These models are also called **colors**. Here are the most common models for you to know.

#### **Green Open Access**



- Publication via an repository or website
- Generally free of charge
- Publication can occur prior to, simultaneously with or after the publisher's publication

## Gold Open Access



- First publication of a work in a Gold Open Access journal / book
- Involves the payment of Article Processing Charges (APCs), usually paid by the respective academic institution

#### **Diamond Open Access**



- Publication in mostly small journals
- Journals get funded
- Publication involves no APCs / BPCs
- Without any fees for authors or readers

# **Hybrid Open Access**



- Publication in subscription-based journal / book
- Payment of APCs to make the publication accessible on the publisher's website upon initial release
- Rest of the journal's / book's content remains behind paywall

## **Bronze Open Access**



- Freely accessible on publisher's server (mostly archives of subscription journals)
- Without clear reuse details

### **Black Open Access**



- Illegal sharing of publications
- Via services such as SciHub
