## 8. Open Science at Saarland University (UdS)

### SciDok

SciDok is Saarland University's publication repository, where publications by university members (including doctoral theses) are archived and made freely accessible to the public.

### Universaar

Universaar is Saarland University's own publishing house. All works published through Universaar are made available online free of charge. Print copies can also be produced for a fee.

### Open Access Agreements with Publishers

Saarland University and SULB provide university members with discounts on Open Access publishing through institutional memberships, participation in consortia, and transformative Open Access agreements with publishers. To find out whether you are eligible for these benefits, please visit the SULB homepage.

### Alternative Funding Options for Open Access Publications

For many publications, members of Saarland University can have their publication fees covered or reduced through the university's Open Access publication fund. Eligibility for funding generally requires meeting the following criteria:



The UdS author must be the corresponding author.



The publication must be licensed under CC BY 4.0.



Saarland University affiliation must be stated in the publication.



The submission must be published in a gold Open Access journal, conference proceeding, or book.



The submission must fall between 1 Apr 2023 and 31 Dec 2027.
